## Been There, Done That — NOT YET!

*We're finding that more travelers today are seeking newer distinct destinations and experiences to explore that they aren't familiar with. They're seeking an activity or somewhere unusual, not the same "been there, done that" type of travel. Let's take a look at a few more unusual trips.*

The Southern Hemisphere is getting a lot of attention for destinations that are new to many. The Galapagos Islands, Ecuador is a great place to start. This chain of 13 islands is in the Pacific Ocean, 600 miles off the west coast of South America. These pristine islands provide an authentic, unfiltered experience of natural animal wonders: sea lions, crabs, iguanas, blue-footed boobies, dolphins, gulls, penguins, and a multitude of other species. It is not even

unusual to see a 500-pound tortoise still roaming since before the Civil War.

The islands are now a UNESCO World Heritage site protecting not only wildlife, but the island's history. It includes Charles Darwin research, World War II military occupation, and more. Visitors to the islands often spend nights onboard the cruise ships that bring them. Visits may include picturesque snorkeling and scuba diving

## DR. SEUSS WATERWORKS PARK TO BE FEATURED ON CARNIVAL'S NEWEST SHIP

Carnival Cruise Line's newest ship, *Carnival Horizon*, will be the first in the fleet to feature Dr. Seuss WaterWorks, a colorful water park inspired by the whimsical world and words of the legendary children's author.

Dr. Seuss WaterWorks will offer two distinctly different slides: The Cat in the Hat slide, featuring an enclosed raft slide offering more than 450 feet of twists and turns; and the Fun Things slide with whimsical polka dots and special lighting effects. The water park coincides with Carnival's fleetwide Seuss at Sea program, which features immersive onboard Dr. Seuss-themed youth, family, dining and entertainment experiences.

The 3,934-passenger *Carnival Horizon* is set to debut in Europe on April 2, 2018.

As a point of embarkation, New York City provides experiences to suit every travel palate. From leisurely rowboat rides on the Lake in Central Park, to the bright lights of the Great White Way, New York prepares cruise travelers for the excitement and relaxation of a voyage leaving from the East Coast of the United States.*

## WAKING UP ON THE WEST SIDE

For many first-time visitors to New York City, the prospect of abiding by a schedule and navigating traffic around the five boroughs can be a daunting task. While the public transportation, ride-sharing options and taxi system are easily accessible once visitors become comfortable, staying at a hotel near the appropriate cruise ship's point of departure might be best for travelers who are not yet familiar with the area's layout.

from the Kentler Flatfiles," from June 17 – July 30, 2017, or "Lucile Bertrand, Travelers and Strangers," which opens September 8 and runs until October 22, 2017. Since its opening in 1990, the

museum has sought to become interwoven with the local community. To continue this mission, the Kentler International Drawing Space also provides educational opportunities for kids and adults including Drawing Together family programs. An Adult Drawing initiative is currently in development.

Since 1986, the Water Front Museum has not only educated the public regarding maritime life aboard the Lehigh Valley Railroad Barge #79, it has also served as a longtime advocate to promote public access to the New York City area's waterfront properties. The museum's founder, David Sharps, was inspired to care for barges during time spent in Paris, following his work as a cruise-ship performer. In addition to exhibitions such as "New York Harbor Scenes," which will run July 6 through October 28, 2017, the Water Front Museum also hosts events including Pirate School and "Sea Shanties and Folk Music by Slackjaw & Holler."

Only a 10-minute taxi ride from Red Hook, Carroll Gardens is home to one of Brooklyn's oldest Italian-American neighborhoods. In this area, visitors will find many enticing culinary and sightseeing options for authentic New York City experiences before embarking on a cruise. For a sampling of some of the neighborhood's flavors, stop by Vinny's of Carroll Gardens to enjoy specialties that reflect the influences of southern Italian cuisine. Another local favorite, Fragole, serves brunch, lunch and dinner, and also offers an extensive wine list for every price point.

An ideal location for cruise departures to the Caribbean, Europe, and autumn sailings along the New England coast to Canada, New York City is a place of wonder and excitement to generate enthusiasm prior to a cruise, yet it can also afford a great deal of respite once travelers return from a vacation. These easily accessible ports within the city facilitate travel and open many possibilities for enhancing any pre- or post-cruise stay.

# CENTRAL FLORIDA: THE ULTIMATE FAMILY VACATION DESTINATION

*There's always something new and exciting happening in central Florida. With so many family-oriented attractions you could easily spend several days in the area and still not experience everything on your must-do list.*

Certainly one of the region's biggest attractions is **Universal Orlando Resort**, which features two sprawling theme parks, a large dining and entertainment complex, and five on-site hotels.

At **Universal Studios Florida** theme park, enjoy cutting-edge attractions based on pop-culture icons, blockbuster films and hit television shows that transport visitors into a highly imaginative world where they can become heroes of their own adventure.

With seven themed islands, **Universal's Islands of Adventure** theme park features imaginative rides and attractions, including The Wizarding World of Harry Potter.

This year, Universal has added a new attraction, **Universal's Volcano Bay**. This innovative water theme park spans 30 acres and includes a multi-directional wave pool with sandy beaches, twisting raft rides, winding river, and speeding body slides that drop from the top of the volcano.

When your day of thrill rides and exploration comes to a close, head to **Universal CityWalk**, a 30-acre entertainment complex offering live music, multiple dining venues, dancing and shopping.

**Walt Disney World's** four Orlando Theme Parks – *Magic Kingdom*, *Epcot*, *Animal Kingdom Theme Park* and *Disney's Hollywood Studios* – make the real world seem far, far away.

In 2016, **Disney's Animal Kingdom** became the site of some new additions. *Sunset Kilimanjaro Safaris* has expanded to include a nighttime schedule that leads visitors through Africa's savanna, while introducing African wild dogs and hyenas to the park. Also new is "Rivers of Light," an innovative entertainment experience set along Discovery River.

In late 2015, Disney opened **Star Wars Launch Bay**, located on a new 14-acre park site at Hollywood Studios. The Star Tours – The Adventures Continue provides guests with insight into the latest movie franchise installment, "Star Wars: The Force Awakens."

If you're in the Tampa Bay area, be sure to visit **Busch Gardens Tampa Bay**. This theme park has received many media accolades, recognized for being an entertainment company that blends imagination with nature.

At the Animal Care Center, guests can observe and even take part in the animal care experience. The Serengeti Plain, a 65-acre habitat, is home to many African animals, including reticulated giraffes, rhinos, wildebeests, antelope and ostriches, which can be seen from the Serengeti Railway, Skyride and various walkways. For thrill seekers, Busch Gardens has added an exciting new spin coaster, which travels at 40 miles per hour and features a 70-foot vertical lift.

Another popular visitor attraction in the Tampa Bay region is **Tampa Bay's Lowry Park Zoo**. The zoo has won many awards for animal preservation, with an emphasis

on endangered and threatened species from climates similar to Tampa Bay. The zoo now cares for more than 1,300 animals. At the David A. Straz, Jr. Manatee Critical Care Center, zoo guests can actually watch the veterinary and animal care staff treat sick, injured and orphaned manatees. This year, park visitors will also have the opportunity to see Dinos Alive! This outdoor exhibit allows guests to get up-close and personal with varying species of dinosaurs that move, roar and interact with them. But hurry, this is a limited-time attraction that is scheduled to close sometime in August 2017.

At **SeaWorld Orlando**, enjoy thrilling rides and up-close encounters with penguins, dolphins, sea lions and sharks. On one of SeaWorld's newest adventure rides, *Antarctica: Empire of the Penguin*, find yourself being transported into the rarely seen and icy world of Antarctica. Another new ride, *Mako*, is the tallest, fastest and longest coaster in Orlando.

If you're looking to capture some of central Florida's cultural attractions, pay a visit to the **Orlando Museum of Art**, which features American art ranging from pre-Colombian to contemporary, plus an African collection. The family-friendly museum also features interactive children's areas where kids can create their

own works of art.

Quaint **Winter Park**, which is located about a 10-minute drive north of downtown, was established in the late 19<sup>th</sup> century as a winter getaway spot for wealthy snowbirds. The best way to see Winter Park, its historic estates and lush greenery is onboard the guide-narrated Scenic Boat Tour, which travels the Winter Park chain of lakes.

One such estate is the **Albin Polasek Museum and Sculpture Gardens**, adjacent to Lake Osceola. The villa, a retirement home that Polasek designed and lived in until his death in 1965, features more than 200 of the Czech-American sculptor's finest creations, in addition to antiquities from his private collection.

Perhaps Winter Park's greatest claim to fame is The Charles Hosmer Morse Museum of American Art, with the world's most comprehensive collection of the works of Louis Comfort Tiffany. One of his greatest works is the astoundingly intricate interior of the Tiffany Chapel, designed for the World's Columbian Exposition in 1893. The museum painstakingly restored the chapel onsite over a span of two years, opening it in 1999.

With a mild climate year round, Florida makes an ideal vacation destination any time of year!

# SAN ANTONIO: A CULTURAL SPARK IN THE LONE STAR STATE

*In San Antonio, Texas, great civic pride is demonstrated through the preservation of history and tradition. The city embraces the many facets of its Tex-Mex heritage and flaunts a spicy Southwest character.*

The historic center of San Antonio has as its core the Mission San Antonio de Valero – better known as the Alamo, which was founded in 1718. In 1836, the legendary battle between General Santa Anna’s Mexican troops and Texas defenders took place, and it is here that famous freedom fighters such as Jim Bowie and Davy Crockett lost their lives. A visit to the Alamo and its surrounding plaza is best appreciated on a guided tour.

Another important icon, which symbolizes the heart and soul of the city, is River Walk, through which the San Antonio River flows. This lovely downtown park area of San Antonio is filled with trees, pathways and stone bridges, and is greatly enjoyed by visitors and residents alike. Be sure to take a relaxing narrated boat ride on which you will likely lose yourself in the beguiling scenery and atmosphere as you drift along this Paseo del Rio learning about the architecture and culture of the city.

In addition to river barge cruises, visitors can tour the River Walk using the city’s bike-share program, B-Cycle. With more than 50 stations throughout downtown, you can tour on two wheels through the Mission Reach extension of River Walk featuring visual and aural works of art, terraces landscaped with native plants, and pedestrian access to the San Antonio Museum of Art and the historic Pearl Brewery complex.

For a glimpse of what life was like in San Antonio’s missions during the 1700s, visit San Antonio Missions National Historical Park. Included in this park are the four southernmost Spanish colonial missions – Concepción, San Jose, San Juan and Espade. Along with the Alamo, these missions have been named a

UNESCO World Heritage Site. All four missions can be explored along the River Walk’s Mission Beach, an eight-mile stretch with recreational trails, picnic areas, pedestrian bridges, pavilions and portals to the missions. Be sure to stop by the park’s visitor’s center in Mission San Jose, where you can view “Gente de Razon,” which tells the story of life in the missions.

Visitors to San Antonio also flock to El Mercado, an outdoor market plaza spanning three blocks that personifies the city’s Mexican heritage with a colorful bazaar of crafts and collectibles, as well as food products and restaurants. Music and dancing representing the region’s folkloric traditions create a special festive flair.

## SAILING FROM GALVESTON, TEXAS

If you’re thinking about taking a cruise to the Eastern, Western or Southern Caribbean – or even the Panama Canal – you may find sailing from Galveston, Texas to be fun and convenient. Situated on Galveston Island in the Gulf of Mexico, this historic city charms visitors with its Victorian architecture, amusement parks and seafood restaurants dishing up scrumptious Gulf shrimp, Louisiana crawfish, Galveston Bay oysters, and soft-shell crabs.

Galveston’s long seawall stretches from beach to beach and offers terrific gulf views the whole way. Spend some time strolling along the famed historic Strand District and have fun shopping in the city’s more than 100 curio shops, outlets, antique stores, art galleries, and numerous museums and gardens.

Sailings from the Port of Galveston are offered by Carnival Cruise Line, Royal Caribbean and Disney Cruise Line. Depending on the length of the cruise,
